

**Peter Willett** is a Professor of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the University of Connecticut. Previously he was at the University of Toronto, from which he received his BAsC in 1982, and at Princeton University from which he received his PhD in 1986. He is a Fellow of the IEEE, and editor in chief for IEEE Transactions on Aerospace and Electronic Systems, associate editor for the International Society for Information Fusion Journal of Advances in Information Fusion (ISIF-JAIF) and was AE for the IEEE AESS Systems magazine and for IEEE Transactions on Systems, Man, and Cybernetics (both parts A and B). He is a member of the IEEE Signal Processing Magazine's editorial board. He was a track organizer for Remote Sensing at the IEEE Aerospace Conference (2001-2003), and was co-chair of the Diagnostics, Prognosis, and System Health Management SPIE Conference in Orlando. He served as Program Co-Chair for the 2003 IEEE Systems, Man & Cybernetics Conference in Washington, DC.
